## **Criteria for selecting the right certificate**

Before applying and adopting to guidelines or certificates, one should check the following questions:

- What is the principal aim of the guidelines or rating? This can be donor orientation, governmental acceptance, or simply public transparency.
- Which quality criteria have to be met? Do these criteria cover your own expectations and values?
- How high are the financial and temporal exposure for your organization? You should check for costs of accreditation, costs of renewal, etc.
- Is there a governmental minimal expectation of self-regulation?

In some countries, governmental institutions expect specific certifications or acceptance of guidelines in order to collaborate or fund a nonprofit.

## • Which constituents do you want to address?

Internal constituents expect other forms of self-regulations than donors or clients.
