GENDER-SENSITIVE

 To be aware of how gender norms, roles and relations influence women's and men's opportunities in society.

GENDER-RESPONSIVE

- To respond to the inequalities by addressing the causes of gender inequality.
- Removing structural barriers to gender equality, transforming discriminatory gender norms, roles and relations.
- Empowering women and ensuring that they know their rights.

GENDER-DISAGGREGATED DATA

Gender-disaggregated data is data broken down by different genders

CHALLENGES IN NEPAL

- 1. Gender-responsive budgeting did not reach the local level
- 2. Lack of gender-disaggregated data
- ▶ Locally elected representatives must apply inclusiveness from planning to the monitoring phase
- ▶ A transformative approach that moves from gender-sensitive to gender-responsive policies can lead to a better functioning of the labour market
